



Calgary Harley-Davidson Motorcycle School

The Calgary Harley-Davidson Motorcycle School team is dedicated to providing new and experienced riders the necessary knowledge and skills to safely ride a motorcycle with confidence.

Two former Police Motor Officers developed the School and curriculum in 1996. The continued success of the School is based on a fundamental curriculum, principles, and discipline shared by Police Departments around the world today and is approved and licensed by Alberta Transportation.

Our current Chief Instructor is also a former Police Motor Officer and continues to develop the School's curriculum using current technologies and techniques.

Our Instructors use interactive hands-on teaching methods with an impressive 3 students per Instructor ratio (Standard Class), the lowest in the business with a maximum of 9 students per class. The standard class includes a 3 hour classroom session (scheduled Thursday evenings) followed by on-track 16 hours of practical training over 2 days (either 2 Saturdays or 2 Sundays in a row) late April to late June. We train on a fleet of 500cc Buell Blast motorcycles specifically developed for new riders and commuters. This bike has a proven track record as being effective in both size and handling for training purposes. This course is \$579.95 + G.S.T. Additional one-on-one training is available at the discretion of the Instructors.

Upon successful completion of the Standard Class, each student should have the necessary skills and confidence to obtain a class 6 designation through Alberta Transportation (Registries). The School offers each successful student the use of the training bikes to take their class 6 road test (limitations apply).

NEW in 2010:

PRIVATE LESSONS:

Calgary Harley-Davidson Motorcycle School now offers one-on-one private motorcycle lessons consisting of the full 16 hours including classroom session with one dedicated Instructor. This course is offered in July and August and dates are agreed upon between Instructor and Student. Fee is \$725.00 + G.S.T.

REFRESHER COURSE:

A 5 hour refresher course is now being offered using your own motorcycle. This class will consist of two Instructors and a maximum of ten students with valid class 6 licenses. This course is not an instruction based course; it is designed to remind the rider through on-track/highway instruction of already learned riding techniques including life-saving exercises and highway riding. Fee is \$175.00 + G.S.T.

INTERMEDIATE COURSE:

An 8 hour intermediate course is also offered for experienced riders with a minimum of 1 year riding experience, a valid class 6 license, AND a prior student of Calgary Harley-Davidson Motorcycle School. The course is designed to challenge the existing skills of the rider using your own motorcycle with a graduated instruction methodology. Fee is \$225.00 + G.S.T.

NOTE:

- Students must provide their own riding gear including rain gear and warm clothing (details on www.calgaryharley.com).
- All courses are mentally and physically challenging. Please use discretion when registering.
- Students **MUST** be 18 years of age or older **AND** hold a valid class 5 license for standard class.
